Hello Everyone,

I attended the Wenatchee DPRC, and the Ellensburg DPRC.

PI: Not sure what is going on in the other Divisions but stuff is popping in Wenatchee.

We have a PI presentation set up on June 15th at Recovery Innovations to about 45 professionals who work with addicts some with other mental disorders. We have 3 people currently preparing with other members helping out.

Yesterday the Wenatchee Division hosted a Phonline Flier Drive & BBQ. We delivered and hung Phonline Fliers to all of Chelan and Douglas Counties and then had a Party to celebrate.

Our Goal was to hit every Grocery Store, Gas Station, Library and Post Office in Chelan and Douglas Counties. The reason we felt this was needed is that currently we only have meetings in Wenatchee, E. Wenatchee, Chelan, Cashmere and Entiat. The rest of the towns in our Division currently receive no services from NA.

H&I: We had an issue on an H&I panel at Barth in Ellensburg. I got a call from a counselor saying they might not want NA to ever come back due to the message that was shared and the behavior of a few members that attended the panel. The issues were drug specific language (long drug-o-logs), attire, erratic behavior and a poor representation of what recovery has to offer.

As it has turned out they are willing to give us another chance but have specifically asked that one of the members never be allowed to return. We currently have a panel set up on June 15th at 6:00pm. I am trying to find a member from Wenatchee or Yakima to step up and become the designated Panel Leader for this Panel who will help train members from Ellensburg to eventually take it over in time.
