Old Business:

- 1) P's & G's ad-hoc committee- Revision sent to web-servant to post. Questions were raised: Do the P'S and G's need to be approved by the groups? After discussion- it was decided that P's and G's did not need to be approved by the groups.

New Business:

- 1) Should the web-servant be in the P's and G's since this is a PR elected committee member? Bo requested that web-servant be taken off the ASC P's & G's due to this being a PR committee member. Bo wrote a motion regarding this and it was agreed to cut the web-servant from CWANA P's and G's.
